What to Watch For

This week we'll read half of the book, 2nd Chronicles. As you read, you'll notice that the events in 2nd Chronicles fills in and runs parallel with another book we've read already. Which is it? ______ (I'll let you discover it:). It's around 970 B.C. King David just died. Israel was still a united nation, under David's son, King Solomon. Watch how things unfold for Solomon and Israel, from the heights of splendor, to a divided kingdom (keep 1 Kings 11 near you). Epitome of God's blessings turning into distractions. As Northern Israel turns their back to God, you'll receive some encouragement from the Southern Judah, with King Asa and Jehoshaphat. They aren't perfect, so rest in our perfect King, Jesus!

While reading 2nd Chronicles, you'll step back into the Psalms. Find a quiet spot, and let God lean, searching our lives with Psalm 101, from our temporary mourning into God's eternal exaltation in Psalm 102. Count your blessings in Psalm 103, be amazed at His creation in Psalm 104, and zoom backwards to remember His story of faithfulness in Psalm 105.
