When Revival Came To Town, by District Supt. Ed Mangham...

Something special is happening in Greenville, Ohio, and it has impacted our very own CMA Church there, pastored by Shawn Harrison. Having experienced revivelINDIANA through the radio broadcast out of Fort Wayne, Indiana, the local Greenville station wanted to see the same unity and outreach take place in Western Ohio. Representatives from the radio station reached out to Time to Revive, inviting the ministry to partner with them in Darke County, Ohio. After conducting a scout trip, the Time to Revive team from Dallas, TX, and Darke County leadership sensed that it was time to begin pursuing revival for themselves. What started out as one planned week, led to three weeks of revival, inspiring other Ohio countries to jump on board.

From August 7-27, the Revive Team rallied Darke County pastors to call their people to prayer and evangelism training. Many churches responded, including our very own CMA Church in Greenville, led by Pastor Shawn Harrison. Shawn challenged his local Alliance Church family to jump in with both feet and something very special has begun to happen.

You see, when God's people begin to pray for the lost, God responds. Equipped with simple evangelism training and bathed in prayer, the Alliance church has begun to engage the community like never before. Take a look at this video that shows the initial days of the initiative.
